NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

*** **Dogs must be registered** and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. Pending numbers are no longer accepted ***

Refunds: No refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. A refund (minus NADAC and Judges Fees) will be given for dogs that come into season or are injured if a written request, including a veterinarian's statement, is made before the start of the trial on Sat. No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond our control. *** In cases where the trial fills, entries and checks of exhibitors that did not make it in will be shredded unless a stamped self addressed envelope is provided for its return.***

Through submission of their entry, the exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules in the current Exhibitors Handbook.

Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of NADAC. The trial committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry.

A limited number of spots are available to exhibitors who volunteer to help.

Move ups: Move ups will be accepted for dogs earning titles until Monday, September 13, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. **Move ups will be allowed Saturday to Sunday.**

Awards: A purple NADAC Qualifying ribbon will be awarded for those achieving a qualifying score. First through Fourth placement rosettes will be awarded for each jump height in all classes. Ribbons will also be awarded for dogs earning new titles. A special rosette will be awarded for dogs earning their Versatility NATCH title.

Proposed Running Order:

Saturday: Check-In will be at 2:00 p.m, briefing and first walk-through at 2:45 p.m., judging to begin at 3:00 p.m.

Sunday: Building will open at 6:20 a.m. Check-In will be at 6:30 a.m., briefing and first walk-through at 7:15 a.m., judging to begin at 7:30 a.m.

Classes will run Elite, Open, Novice and dogs will run small to tall both days. (Dogs may be moved across jump heights or classes to accommodate workers or handlers with multiple dogs.)

Saturday: Tunnelers, Weavers, Touch N Go

Sunday: Touch N Go (Rnds 1&2), Weavers (Round order to be determined by judge), Tunnelers (Rnds 1&2)

This order is subject to change after entries close. Please check confirmations carefully for any changes.

Measuring: All dogs entered in the <u>proficient</u> category at the 4", 8", 12", and 16" jump heights must be measured or present a permanent NADAC jump height card. **Dogs entered in the Skilled category no longer need to be measured.** Check-in will be only for dogs needing to be measured. To facilitate check-in, you may attach a photocopy of the permanent jump height card with your entry.

Equipment: Obstacles that may be used in this trial include: **Rubberized Dogwalk**, **Rubberized A-Frame (8-foot)**, Open Tunnels, Hoops and Weave Poles.

Take the next exit at Rimrock Rd (Exit # 262). Turn right on Rimrock, then right on E. Badger Rd. The Emergency Vet clinic is on the left.

Trial Site Information

Ring size is 100 X 60. Flooring is thick stall matting covered with non-slip, solid surface, rubber roof membrane. Crating space is available. Please use mats or towels under wire crates and x-pens to protect the floor surface. No grooming in the building. You must pick up after your dog. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial with no refund of entry fees.

Food: There will be no food available on site, but there are several fast food places near by on Fish Hatchery Rd. and Park St. **Food will be provided for volunteer workers**.

Parking: Mad City's parking lot, either side of Post Rd., and across the street in H&H Electric's parking lot are all available for parking. **Do Not** block loading docks at H&H Electric at any time! **Park only in designated parking spots at H&H Electric**—please respect their property and do not potty dogs anywhere except on MCDT's designated pott y areas!

From North and South: I 90 and I 39 exit at HYW 12 and 18 West (Also known as the Beltline) Exit at Park St./Hwy 14 and turn South (left) on HWY 14. Go about ½ mi and exit at MM / McCoy Rd and turn right on McCoy Road. Take the first right turn on to Syene Rd. At the first intersection, turn left on Post Rd. Mad City is the blue and tan building on the left.

From East: I 94 to I 90 and I 39 South. Follow above directions.

From West: Take Hwy 18 East until Hwy 14. Exit South on HWY 14 to McCoy Rd. Go West (right) on McCoy Rd. Turn right on Syene Rd. Left on Post Rd. Mad City is on the left.

Current NADAC Rules

For a full description of current NADAC rules please refer to the NADAC Exhibitor Handbook, dated November 1, 2008, which can be found on the NADAC Webpage at NADAC.com or <u>http://www.nadac.com/rules.htm</u>

Proficient/Skilled Categories:

Each class will be split into two categories, Proficient and Skilled. In the Skilled Category dogs must jump 4" lower than their Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. (No dog may jump less than 4") Dogs jumping 4" lower will get the SCT of the lower jump height.

Dogs must be entered in one category, either Proficient or Skilled, for the entire weekend.

Non-Jumping Classes

Veteran or Disabled Handler:

Handlers aged 60 or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may opt to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10 % more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the <u>NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com</u> list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the <u>www.NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com</u> list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (Including NADAC officers, employees and members), Southern Wisconsin Paws-4-Fun Agility Club, Inc. (including its officers, directors, and event organizing committee), Mad City Dog Training (including its officers, agents and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
- 1.6 Exhibitor understands there is a returned check fee of \$25.00.
- 1.7 Exhibitor understands that they are responsible for their and their dogs conduct. Failure to comply can be a reason for dismissal from the trial; including no refund of monies and elimination of all scores obtained during the trial.

In consideration of the acceptance of the entry, I/We agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC in effect at the time of this trial, and by any additional rules and regulations as approved by the board of NADAC for this trial. I/We certify that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or to other dogs. I/We further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed above.
